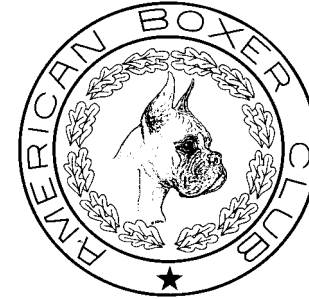

Limited Trial - Entry Limits: 300 Runs Per Day

This event will be held indoors, using one fully matted (rubber over 3/4" foam) ring 85 ft. by 100 ft.. 24in weaves, electronic timing, rubberized contacts.

Time Judging Begins: 8:00am both days

Entry Fee: \$25, first entry, \$13 second entry, and \$10 for the third entry of the same dog on the same day (Includes \$3 AKC Recording fee plus \$3 for additional entries of same dog)

Note: *FAST and T2B classes will be offered on Tuesday only.*

All-breed trial (Monday) : Opening date for all entries is March 7, 2012 at 8am. Entries for boxers will be given priority until March 13, 2012, after which time entries for all breeds will be accepted in the order they are received until the closing date of Friday, April 20, 2012. No confirmation of entries will be distributed for breeds other than Boxers until after March 13, 2012.

Boxer only trial (Tuesday): Opening date for all entries is March 7, 2012 at 8am. Closing date - Friday, April 20, 2012

After April 20, 2012, entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or altered, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All the rules and regulations as they appear in the latest Regulations for Agility Trials shall apply.

Awards

Rosettes and either a small stuffed toy or a dog food sample (value less than \$2) will be awarded to the first through fourth place dogs in each jump height and each class. A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. A rosette will be given to those finishing an agility title. A MACH or PACH bar and rosette will be awarded to any team completing a MACH or PACH title. Additionally, all boxers placing 1st thru 4th in their class will be given an ABC medallion.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the North: South on I-75, east on I-275 (exit #15), Take exit #46, go north on Rte. 42. Turn left at first traffic light once you've crossed I-275 (Hauck Road). Go West on Hauck Road for about 3/4 mile. Right on Tramway Drive, go to end - Queen City building is at end of cul-de-sac, on your right.

From the South: North on I-75, east on I-275 (exit #15), Take exit #46, go north on US 42. Follow directions above to Hauck Road and Tramway Drive.

From the East or West: From I-275, take exit #46, go north on US 42. Follow directions above to Hauck Road and Tramway Drive.



There will be no contact obstacle familiarization for the Novice classes.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Express Mail and deliver service entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

Errors on entry forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. Whoever shall make such errors, no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please TYPE or PRINT CAREFULLY the information on the entry form to minimize errors.

Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with identification numbers and a Judging program. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Faxed, telegraphed, telephoned, e-mailed, unsigned entries, or entries not on an official AKC Agility entry form (or photocopy) with Agreement and instructions attached cannot be accepted.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified excused, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. For bitches in season on the day of the trial, entry fee, less \$5 per run, will be refunded upon adequate proof of such.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Injured dogs and bitches in season- Entry fee, less \$5 per run, will be refunded upon presentation of a note from a veterinarian stating that the bitch is in season or the dog is unable to compete due to injury. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund prior to the start of classes or by letter postmarked prior to May 9, 2011.

Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether needs to be measured. **You do not have to submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with the entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a **\$25.00** service charge for returned checks.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

.This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

FAST & T2B classes will also be offered on Tuesday only.

Preferred Classes - Available in standard, jumpers, T2B and FAST classes for any dog eligible for this trial. Jump heights are 4 inches lower than the regular classes. All dogs entering Preferred classes for the first time must enter at the Novice level. Dogs may be entered in either regular classes or preferred classes at the same set of trials, but not both.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions.

Dogs entered in Preferred Classes must jump at their regulation height.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner. **For the first day entered in the trial, this request must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6pm, Monday, April 30.** Dogs may be moved up on Tuesday, if they received their title at the Monday trial, providing the request is made by the end of competition on Monday. Information needed for move-up: Full name of dog and AKC registration number, original class and class to be moved into. Dogs moved up will be entered at end of the running order.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles are as listed in the current Regulations For Agility Trials from the American Kennel Club.

TRIAL VENUE

This event will be held in an air conditioned building, on thick rubber matting (with newly installed soft underpads). There will be one ring, 100ft x 85ft..

Entry Information

First received opening date: Wednesday, March 7 , 8am. at 502 Blossom Hill Ln, Cincinnati, OH. No hand delivery accepted for the first 24 hours.

In the event a delivery, in which a numerical limit has been reached, contains entries in excess of that limit, entries will be selected from that delivery by random draw. A maximum of 10 entries per envelope is allowed. After April 20, entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or altered, except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. All the rules and regulations as they appear in the latest iRegulations for Agility Trials shall apply.

Show Site Information

FOOD CONCESSIONS and indoor restrooms are available on site.

Dogs may be exercised on show site only. Keep our neighbors happy. Dogs are not allowed in Fossil Park. Please clean up after your dog. Small plastic bags are provided at the trial site for dog waste pickup. Waste containers are available in designated potty areas. There is no overnight parking for campers and motor homes at show site. Camping sites with restrooms are available at Winton Woods, approximately 5 miles from site. To reserve camp-sites (RVís, campers, etc.) call 513-851-2267.

Crating

There is ample inside crating for all exhibitors, as a result of the recent building expansion.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles are as listed in the current edition of Regulations For Agility Trials from the American Kennel Club. **There will be no obstacle familiarization for the Novice classes.**

Move-up Regulations - Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner. For move-ups prior to the trial, this request must be made to the Trial Secretary by 6 p.m., Monday, April 30. For move-ups on Tuesday, May 8, this request must be made by the end of competition on Monday, May 7. Information needed for move-up: Full name of dog, registration number, original class and class to be moved to. Dogs moved up will be entered at end of the running order.

Note: only mail or email move-ups will be accepted for Monday's trial.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
