1. Each Specialty Breed Club will adhere to all COVID rules, regulations, and protocols mandated by the State of Wisconsin, Waukesha County, and the Waukesha Expo Center. All participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held. To find the latest guidelines for the location of these shows, please access www.waukeshacounty.gov/HealthandHumanServices/PublicHealth/public-health-preparedness/COVID19/gatherings or the Waukesha County Expo Center Web site.
2. If masks are required, they must cover your mouth and nose at all times unless stated below. **If you do not follow this rule, you will be asked to leave and receive no refund.** Judges will have the authority to ask exhibitors to leave if they feel the rules are not being followed. Please respect all club members and superintendents, social distance, and do not remove your mask if masks are required. Many volunteers and participants are in high-risk categories. They are working the shows for you, so respect them and don't put them at additional risk.
3. Rings:
 - a. Additional rings may be put up and spread around the fairgrounds to allow for social distancing including in buildings and outdoors. Please be aware of where your ring may be. There is no withdrawal of entry if your ring location is changed. Judges may also change to handle any overflow.
 - b. All rings will have separate entrance and exit. Six feet will be marked from the ring for social distancing. All buildings will have a separate entrance and exit where possible. Please follow signs to avoid roadblocks.
 - c. Please keep aisles as clear as possible and no socializing at ring areas. Hand sanitizer stations will be available at all entrances, including at ringside.
4. Grooming:
 - a. No forced air dryers or fans will be allowed in the grooming areas in the buildings. Small individual crate fans or hand-held, small blow dryers can only be used.
5. Show catalogs and arm bands:
 - a. Show catalogs for each show held Friday-Sunday will be available for sale at the entrance gate. Three-day passes, good for Friday-Sunday, will be available upon entry to the show grounds.

- b. Armbands will be at a separate table. No armbands will be given out at ringside. Know your number before requesting an armband.
6. These shows are open to the public. No chairs will be provided for spectators or exhibitors.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs with their own equipment in the entire facility, including Ex-pens. There will be no public scoops.
8. Additional recommendations:
 - a. Consider wearing washable or disposable gloves.
 - b. Wash hands as often as possible. If you cannot wash your hands, use hand sanitizer frequently.
 - c. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
 - d. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
 - e. Avoid common use pens/pencils. Bring your own.
9. If you are feeling ill on the day of the show, particularly if you are exhibiting symptoms of COVID 19 like fever, cough, sneezing, loss of smell or taste, and acute respiratory illness consistent with COVID, please stay home.
10. When a club member/volunteer asks you to do something, please realize that they are doing this to follow regulations and do NOT take any irritations out on them. We will not hesitate to ask you to leave if we feel you are being abusive.
11. Stay safe and enjoy the shows!

RESERVED GROOMING

A limited number of indoor, A/C, Reserved grooming spots will be available on a first come, first reserved basis. Limit 2 spaces per exhibitor. NOTE – only human hand-held dryers & small, individual crate fans will be allowed indoors. WKC plans for outdoor bathing & electric nearby for use of high-force blow dryers. Common-use tables may be available. Plan to bring your own. WKC provides several large outdoor grooming tents with electric access. Bring your own extension cords.

A waiting list will be kept and filled if cancellations are received. Reserved spaces have access to shared electric but is not exclusive and is not reserved. If you wish to groom next to each other, you must send in the same envelope and we will attempt to accommodate as best possible. Spaces measure approximately 5' x10'. \$25 for the show weekend, no partial reservations accepted.

If the State of WI or Expo Rules prohibit indoor spaces before the show, you will be notified by email. Notice will also be posted on our website/FB page. All checks will be shredded.

EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to a show committee hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club.

- The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATV's must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.
- Day RV Parking ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV parking area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3. Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, a parking pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
 - o Recreational vehicles with proper parking pass displayed in the window.
 - o Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper parking forms displayed in window. One vehicle per site. Any handler/exhibitors without proper parking confirmations must enter through Gate #1 and use the designated "Handler Drop Off area."
 - o Club members and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 9:00PM, RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available. Wednesday arrivals are welcome from Noon – 9:00PM.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10 p.m. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind are allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 ft. or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. Failure to follow this rule may result in additional charges or not being allowed to camp on-site for future shows.
- Cancellations of RV Camping and Handler Parking: A full refund will be given if canceled on or before July 14, 2021. If canceled July 14, 2021 or later, the reservation fee will be forfeited.

As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class. Refer to each Breed Section for eligibility.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is allowed two get and not more than four. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

• NOTE •

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

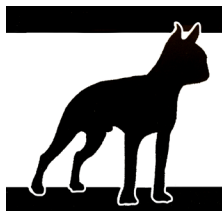

At every licensed or member club rally trial, a recording fee of \$3.50 is required for the first entry of each dog and a recording fee of \$3.00 is required for each additional entry of the same dog.
- No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club and/or Baray Events assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent. RESPONSIBILITY FOR COMPLETENESS OF ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH ENTRANT.
- RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. BaRay Events will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
- REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
- Females in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the Superintendent is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the Clubs is required to refund the entry fee. The Clubs may retain a processing fee and must publish this information in the premium. Clubs may determine the documentation, if any that is required to confirm the female is in season. This shall be stated in the premium. Note: No fee is paid to the AKC for females in season who are withdrawn.
- FAX ENTRIES – Fax entries will be accepted up to closing time. Fee is \$4.00 per dog per show. If the credit card charge is denied for any reason, an additional service charge of \$20.00 will be added. FAX NUMBER: 360-755-2248. This is for Fax Machine ONLY. Incomplete or illegible Fax entries are not acceptable as a valid entry in a show. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (under AKC Rule Ch. 11, Sec. 4). - Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with entry acknowledgment and judging program to address on entry. Should Exhibitor NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, PLEASE notify BaRay Events at 360-755-7086 or email dogshows@barayevents.com.
- Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show NO REFUND will be made. Neither the club nor its Superintendent will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs.
